Loads of bright cherry & strawberry fruit. Medium bodied. Great red meat all rounder.				
5. Nampo Malbec (13.5%)	£6.00	£8.00	£15.50	£22.00
<i>Mendoza, Argentina</i>				
"Cranberry and jammy red berry scents come with a hint of cinnamon powder. A tight, juicy palate is linear, while spicy red berry and plum flavours finish bright." (Wine Enthusiast).

<i>Valle Central, Chile</i>				
Blueberry and plum notes. Medium bodied. Great balance between fruit, soft tannin & fresh acidity.

- 7. Martín Códax Alba Martín Albariño, Rias Baixa, Spain (12%)** **£27.00**
"GOLD MEDAL" (Concurso Nacional de Vinos Jóvenes) Intense & elegant aromas of white stone fruits & white flowers. The proximity to the sea adds freshness & the granitic soils enhance its natural minerality. Medium-bodied, fresh with an impressive persistence.
- 8. Pommier Chablis, Burgundy, France (12.5%)** **£48.00**
Certified ORGANIC! "89/100. OUTSTANDING...excellent density & power to the mouth coating flavors that terminate in an equally refreshing, clean, dry & more mineral-driven finale that is just a bit firmer...worth checking out." (Burghound, Oct 10, 2021)
- 9. Cecilia Beretta Brognoligo Soave, Veneto, Italy (13.5%)** **£28.00**
Certified Organic! 2018: "88/100. Strong notes of vanilla, nutmeg & cinnamon dominate the ripe yellow fruit aromas on the nose. Enters big & round..finishing long." (Vinous)
Brognoligo: a small sub-area within the Soave Classico region. Made from the top quality grape Garganega, partially dried on the vines. Partly barrel fermented.
- 10. Currabridge Chardonnay, South Eastern Australia (12.5%)** **£24.00**
Ripe varietal fruit on the nose consisting of white peach and melon aromas. The palate is full of punchy citrus and melon flavours which have a fresh and lingering finish.
- 11. Château de la Jannière Muscadet Sur Lie, Loire, France (12%)** **£26.00**
"Family owned since 1924...clean/crisp & minerally...one tenth of the price of a premier cru Puligny...beautiful quality..relatively low yields & meticulous winemaking." (La Revue du France de Vin). Outstanding with seafood & poultry dishes.
- 12. Green and Social Organic Verdejo, Rueda, Spain (13%)** **£22.00**
A typically fresh Verdejo. Aged on lees. It has juicy apple, pineapple, pear & herb aromas carry to the juicy palate. Great with fuller flavoured dishes.
- 13. Saladini Pilastrini Pecorino, Marche, Italy (13.5%)** **£31.00**
"Pecorino has good varietal typicality: mid-straw yellow hue, a nose fragrant with firm lemony fruit, jasmine and herbs, and some peachy ripeness. It's steel aged – no oak – and has good weight. Crisp and aromatic, it's worth trying as an alternative to Sauvignon Blanc or Pinot Grigio." (Decanter)

- 14. Rioja Vega Semi Crianza, Rioja Alta, Spain (14%)** **£22.00**
"GOLD MEDAL" (Mundus Vini) Mostly Tempranillo with Grenache. 4 months in oak barrel. Medium to full bodied with strawberry, plum notes with balanced toasty warmth.
- 15. Camille Cayran Abelia Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Rhône, France (14.5%)** **£24.00**
"GOLD MEDAL" (Concours des Vins Orange) Aromas of blueberry, blackberry, plum. Lifted notes of violets & hint of black pepper. Very smooth & richly textured,
- 16. Desire Lush & Zin Primitivo, Puglia, Italy (13.5%)** **£28.00**
"4 STARS..deliciously approachable...inviting aromas of dark plums, black cherries, wild berries, vanilla, coffee & subtle dried herb notes...smooth & rounded on the palate...engaging ripe fruit flavours & soft tannins & subtle oak...vibrant depth of flavour, personality & a pleasing dry finish." (Gavin Hubble WINE GUY, New Zealand).
- 17. Terra Pura Cabernet Sauvignon, Valle Central, Chile (13%)** **£20.00**
Classic Cabernet aromatics of blackcurrant & violet. Medium to full bodied. Luscious & structured. Vegan friendly.
- 18. Château Vieux Barrail Bordeaux Supérieur 2018, Bordeaux, France (13.5%)** **£27.00**
Elegant notes of dried cranberry, dried herbs & pomegranate with a velvety, dry-yet-fruity medium-full body & a warming, compelling, medium-long finish evoking shades of charcuterie, forest fruits & subtle oak flavour. Merlot dominated with Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc.
- 19. Currabridge Shiraz, South Eastern Australia (13.5%)** **£24.00**
Aged on French oak staves & allowed to mature prior to bottling. Subtle aromas of raspberry & spicy fruit. A flavoursome palate with savoury blackcurrant & stewed plum characters, integrated with lingering vanilla oak flavours.
- 20. Loron Pinot Noir '1711', Vins de France (13%)** **£28.00**
Stylish "everyday" drinking Pinot without paying Burgundy prices! Sourced from fruit from Beaujolais as well as southern France. Classic. Light to medium bodied.

ROSE

- 21. Island Fox Zinfandel Blush Rose, Puglia, Italy (12%)** **£21.00**
Juicy and zesty medium sweet rose with red fruit flavours.
- 22. Hörner Horny Rosé, Pfalz, Germany (11.5%)** **£28.00**
"A crisp fun in the glass for the summer, not too flabby, not too much residual sugar. Before you know it and the bottle is empty." (Vinum 2021) Chosen as one of "Germany`s Coolest Wines" (German Wine Institute) Lovely cranberry, strawberry and cherry aromas and flavours.
- 23. White Zinfandel** (18.7cl) **£6.00**

SPARKLING

- 24. Abelé 1757 Brut N.V., Champagne, France (12%)** **£69.00**
One of Champagne's oldest Grands Marques Houses, founded in 1757. It was served on board the Titanic! A bottle of Henri Abelé Brut was among the 7000 artefacts! "91/100...hints of ripe plum, toast, crunchy white peach and lemon pith, with a zesty, minerally underpinning on the palate. A well-meshed version, offering a firm, clean-cut finish." (Wine Spectator)
- 25. Romeo & Juliet Prosecco Spumante NV, Veneto, Italy (11%)** **£32.00**
Lightly aromatic, easy-drinking with a soft mousse and an off-dry feel. Gentle flavours of lemon, clementine and white apple are lifted by soft acidity.
- 26. Romeo & Juliet Prosecco Spumante NV, Veneto, Italy (11%)** (18.7cl) **£8.00**

DESSERT

- 27. La Fleur d'Or Sauternes, Bordeaux, France (13.5%)** (37.5cl) **£18.00**
An immediately inviting nose, combining apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness, leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate. Luscious but never cloying.
